PARENT & CAMPER ORIENTATION

PARENT DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

DROP-OFF

All Campers: 8:50am - 9:20am

Drop-off will be in front of the Welcome Center. Staff will direct you to the proper location. Please do not park, instead pull up and our counselors will assist campers out of the car. Counselors will greet and escort campers to their meeting area.

PICK-UP

- We ask that all parents stay in their cars on line.
- Once the buses have pulled out, staff will direct you where to park.
- Please sign out your child to the left of the Welcome Center.

IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED IN ORDER FOR A CAMPER TO BE RELEASED - PLEASE HAVE PHOTO ID ON HAND.

EARLY PICK-UP POLICY

- Please let us know by phone or email no later than 2:00pm if you plan on picking your child up.
- All campers leaving early must be signed out by 2:45pm to ensure proper organization for general departure.
- All parents must sign out their camper in the Welcome Center at the main desk.
- A counselor will escort your child to the Welcome Center
- Campers may NOT be picked up between 2:45pm and 3:45pm.

BUS TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

- Must be submitted by *Bus Mail, note, email or phone call* to the camp by 2:00pm on the day of the change.
- Play Dates – parents of BOTH campers must make requests for campers to go home with one another.

Please note: there is limited space on all buses and while we cannot guarantee all requests, we will do our best to accommodate your family.
